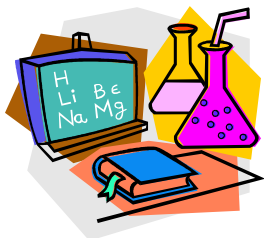


## History

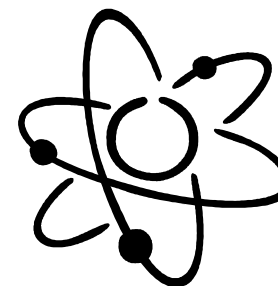

What began solely as a science day for students has evolved into a broad experience for children, adults, and families from all over the tri-state area. Now in its 17th year, Super Science Saturday is an annual, half-day, non-competitive event providing a showcase for the variety of scientific explorations and applications that are alive in our community.
